**Administrator Guide**

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This document provides step-by-step instructions for configuring the Schoology app that will connect to VHL Central, installing the app for the organization and courses, and providing the VHL team details required to complete the integration configuration.

**⚠ Important!** The person who creates the Schoology app to connect to VHL Central will be the only person who can modify the app and the only person who can install it on individual courses.

### Required Role & Permissions

The person completing these steps must log into Schoology as a user whose role has the following settings:

- **Role Type:** Faculty - Admin, Instructor, Advisor
- **Permissions**
  - Administration Settings > System Administration
    - View courses
      - Administer courses
    - Administer applications
  - Schoology Apps and APIs > Schoology Apps
    - Install applications
    - Develop apps
    - Access to app center

To validate or update these details, go to **Tools > User Management**.

- To see the role assigned to a user, go to **Manage Users > Roles/Advanced**.
- To see the role type for the role, go to **Roles**.
- To see the role's permissions, go to **Permissions**.

### Schoology App Configuration

1. Click the :Schoology\_waffle: (4-square waffle) menu > App Center.

**Note:** If you do not see the menu, you may be missing the following permission: Schoology Apps and APIs > Schoology Apps > **Access to app center**.

2. Click the My Developer Apps link.

**Note:** If you do not see the link, you may be missing the following permission: Schoology Apps and APIs > Schoology Apps > **Develop apps**.

3. Click the **Add App** button.

4. Add the app details as shown in the sections below.

- a. General Details
- b. LTI 1.3 Details

5. Check the **This application meets the Schoology Terms of Use** checkbox.

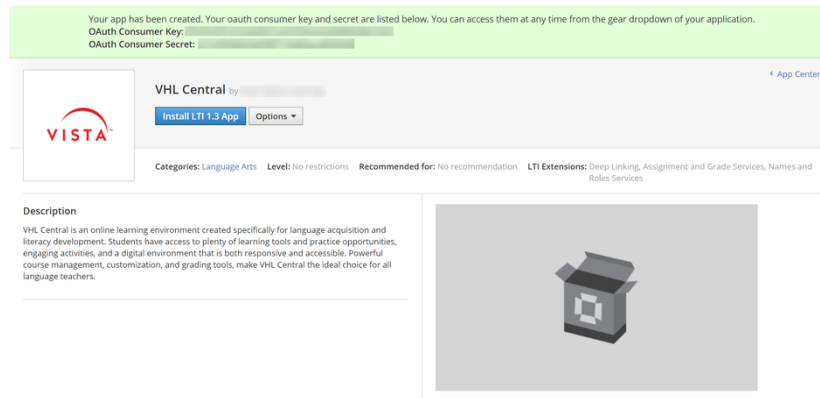

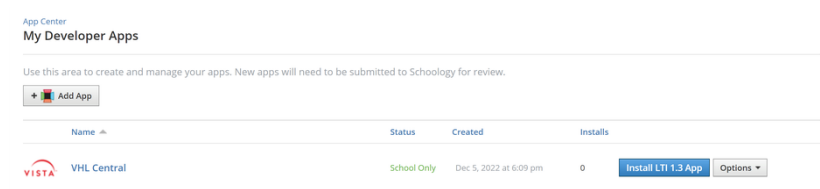

After clicking **Submit** to add the app, Schoology will display the app details page with a confirmation that the app was created successfully.



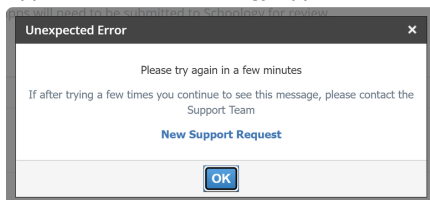
Going forward, your My Developer Apps page will list the app as well.



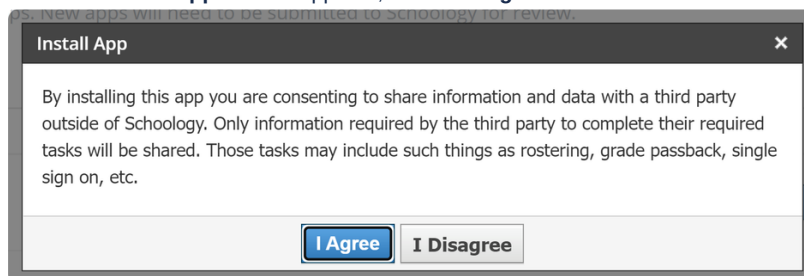
1. Click the **Install LTI 1.3 App** button.

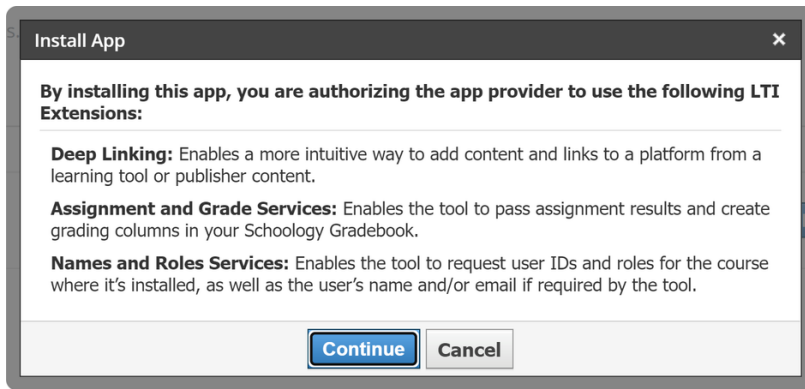


2. When the **Install App** window appears, click the **I Agree** button to authorize Schoology to share data with VHL Central.

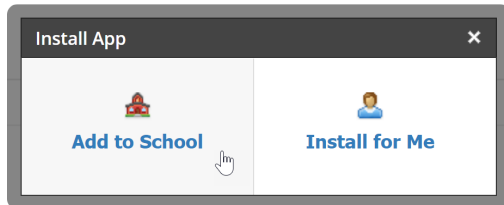


3. When the next window appears, click the **Continue** button to authorize VHL Central to access Schoology's LTI Extensions.





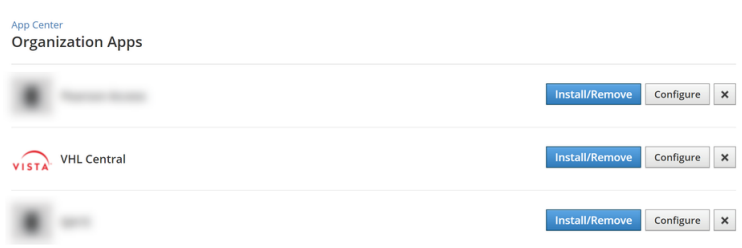
4. When the next window appears, you should see two options; click the **Add to School** button.



- **Note:** If you do not see any options, you may be missing the following permission: Administration Settings > System Administration > **Administer applications.**



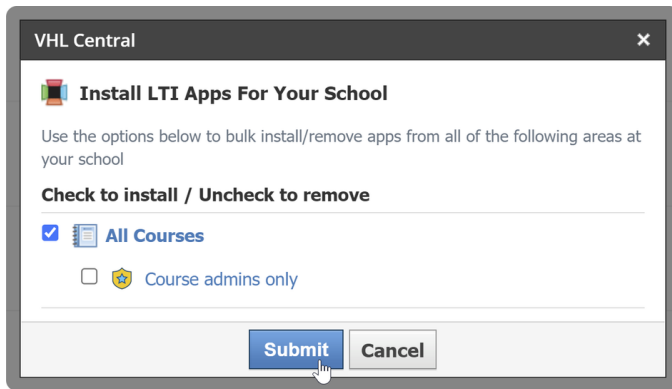
5. When installation is complete, Schoology will go to the Organization Apps page and the **VHL Central** app will be included in your organization's list of apps.



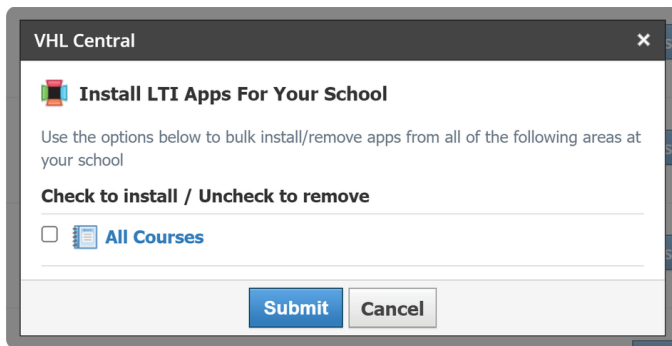
6. For the **VHL Central** app, click the **Install/Remove** button.

### WORKAROUND STEPS for a Schoology deep linking bug

1. Check the **All Courses** checkbox.
2. Click the **Submit** button.



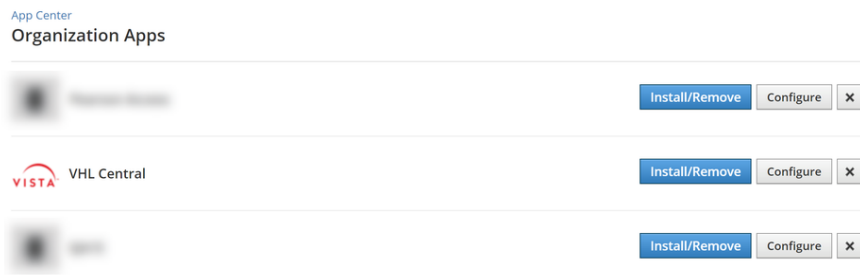
3. If you want to install the VHL Central app for all courses (regardless of Subject Area), **stop here**. If you want to install VHL Central app for individual courses as needed, continue by clicking the **Install/Remove** button again.
4. Uncheck the **All Courses** checkbox.



5. Click the **Submit** button.

## LTI Platform Creation

1. In Organization Apps, find the **VHL Central** app and click its **Configure** button.



2. Copy the **Deployment ID** value.

**Note:** The Deployment ID is composed a Client ID that uniquely identifies the Schoology app and the Schoology school ID for the district or top-level school. These two values are required to configure the LTI Platform in VHL Central.

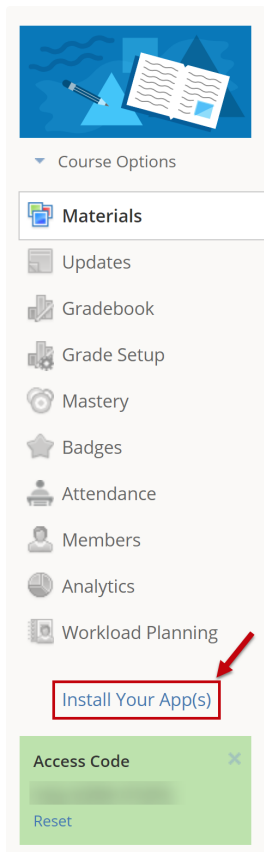
4. VHL Central technical support will create the LTI Platform and advise when it has been verified.

## App Installation on Individual Courses

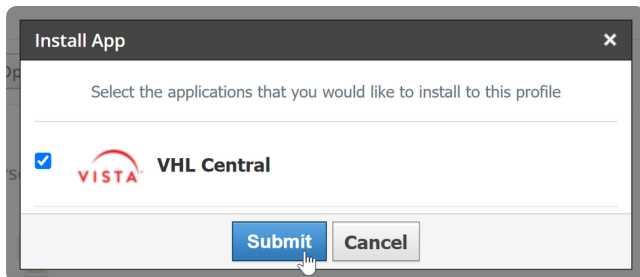
Only the person who created the app can install the app in courses.

1. Go to the course where you want to add the VHL Central app.
  - **Note:** If you cannot access the courses, you may be missing the following permission: Administration Settings > System Administration > View Courses > **Administer courses** or, if you cannot be assigned that permission, you may need the instructor to add you as a course administrator.
2. Click the **Install your App(s)** link on the bottom of the left hand navigation panel.



3. When the **Install App** window opens, check the box for the **VHL Central** app.

4. Click the **Submit** button.



5. On the left hand navigation panel, you will see a link for newly installed app.
