



## VHL Central Course Management Integration – Canvas

### Overview

The VHL Central Course Management Integration for Canvas allows:

- For a one-to-one relationship between your VHL Central course and your Canvas course rosters.
- You to get to your VHL Central account from Canvas via one login.
- Students to get to their VHL Central assignments from Canvas via one login.

## Is integration suitable for your institution?

This level of integration may not be appropriate for all institutions, because it requires commitment on part of both the instructors teaching the course and the institution's IT support staff or Canvas Administrator to set up and maintain the integration. The purpose of this document is to help you decide whether the benefits outweigh the work required to successfully setup and maintain the integration.

## What is needed to get started?

- Your school must have an installation of Canvas.
- Vista Higher Learning must be set up as an External Tool within Canvas. Contact your institution's Canvas Administrator or Information Technology staff to assist with this step of the integration.
- Your VHL Central instructor account for your program should have a corresponding course and section for each Canvas course you wish to integrate.
- Each of your students will need an account on your school's Canvas server and an active VHL Central account with sufficient access for your program's VHL Central course.

## How does integration work?

After you have set up courses in both platforms and your Canvas Administrator has completed set-up within Canvas, as an instructor you can:

- Associate your VHL Central account with your Canvas account, so whenever you login to Canvas, you will also be logged into your VHL Central account.
- Link your VHL Central courses to your Canvas courses.
- Compare VHL Central and Canvas course rosters to confirm which students are enrolled.

When students log into the Canvas course, they can:

- Log into their VHL Central account within Canvas to synch their login. In future Canvas sessions, students will be automatically logged into their VHL Central account (and VHL Central course).
