

Deep Linking


Deep Linking is a LTI-A feature that will allow you to place links in your LMS course (e.g.; Canvas) that will link the following options from VHL

Create a link to the student dashboard, which provides easy access to upcoming assigned work. You can add this same link into multiple locations of your course, and it will always show the work relevant based on the current date.



Gradebook Synch

Using LTI-A, you may set up a grade book synchronization. What this means is that columns based on settings you select will pass TO your LMS (e.g., Canvas). Note this is a one-way communication path, VHL will not retrieve any score data from the district LMS

Cumulative - one aggregate score for a student is sent to the LMS Gradebook

Lesson - Grades at a lesson level are sent to the LMS Gradebook

Week - Grades at a week level are sent to the LMS Gradebook

Category - Grades at a category level are sent to the LMS Gradebook

Overall, it is our experience instructors use a cumulative or category rollup. Obviously if you synch by Lesson, the LMS gradebook will have MANY columns from VHL.

The synch runs in the background. Once the due date hits for a given assignment - the score is reported back to the LMS, and updated regularly.
